Initiation of the Case




Commission received a leniency application





Commission conducted an investigation and exercised its compulsory investigatory powers under the Competition Ordinance



Enforcement Outcomes

Early Cooperating Parties*

- 6 hotel groups
- 1 tour counter operator
- Commission issued
 Infringement Notices
- to them in January 2021
 All of them accepted the Infringement Notices and made commitments to comply

Cooperating Respondents

- Gray Line (including its Managing Director)
- Intercontinental Grand
 Stanford Hong Kong (ICGS)
- Jointly seeking orders before the Competition Tribunal to allow the proceedings to be disposed of by consent:
- Declaration of contravention of the First Conduct Rule
- Imposition of fines after cooperation discount:
 - Gray Line: HK\$4,177,000
 - ICGS: HK\$1,600,000
- Recovery of Commission's costs
- Director Disqualification Order against
 Managing Director of Gray Line for 3 years
